Objective

Team Composition

Evaluation Criteria

Judges will evaluate teams based on:

- **Innovation and Creativity** – Uniqueness of the idea
- **Feasibility and Practicality** – Real-world potential and implementation
- **Market Understanding** – Target audience and scalability
- **Financial Planning** – Budget clarity and revenue model
- **Presentation Skills** – Communication, confidence, and persuasiveness

Rules and Restrictions

- The idea must be **original** (not previously submitted or publicly launched).
- No use of **offensive, illegal, or controversial content**.
- Teams must adhere strictly to **time limits**.

Funding Simulation

- The judges ("Sharks") may offer **hypothetical investments** based on the business potential.
- These investments are **symbolic** and do not represent real financial transactions.

Awards and Recognition

- Prizes or recognition may be given for:
 - **Best Business Idea**
 - **Most Innovative Pitch**
 - **Best Presentation**
 - **Audience Choice Award** (if applicable)

Conduct and Fair Play

Objective

- Score points by knocking the opponent's bottle off the pole or hitting the pole with the disc.

Gameplay

- Teams alternate throwing the Frisbee toward the opponent's pole.
- The throwing team tries to knock the bottle off or hit the pole.
- The defending team tries to:
 - Catch the Frisbee before it hits the ground, or
 - Catch the bottle before it hits the ground.

Scoring

- Points are awarded only if the defense fails to make a catch.
 - point: Disc hits the pole and defense does not catch the disc.
 - points: Bottle is knocked off and defense does not catch the bottle.
 - points: Disc hits the pole and knocks the bottle off, and neither is caught.
- If the defense catches the disc or bottle before it hits the ground, no points are scored.

Serving Rules

- Teams alternate throws.
- Both teammates must throw before the other team throws again.
- A foot fault (stepping past the pole while throwing) cancels the throw.
Games are usually played to 11 points.
- You must win by 2 points.
- If both teams go over 11 in the same round, play continues.
